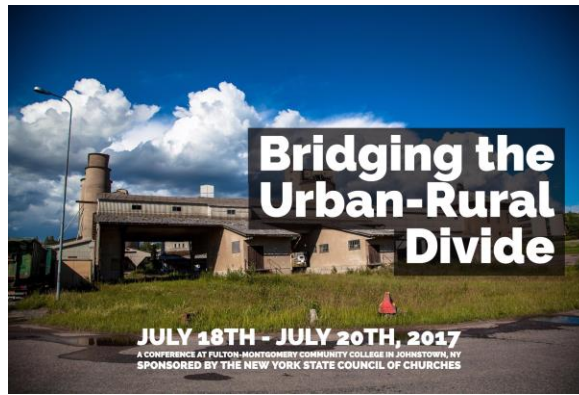


BRIDGING THE URBAN-RURAL Divide
